George Rhys October Artist of the Month

I knew I wanted to be an artist at age four. One grandfather, descended from professional artists and a part-time artist himself, drew whatever we asked for. He gave me a painting for my fourth birthday. My other grandfather bought my drawings for a quarter and saved them for me. My mother died when I was three and my step-mother is the niece of a famous illustrator. Our house was decorated with many paintings by several artists. Yet my parents refused me lessons.

If only I hadn't been outstanding at math, I could have opted out of that path selected for me. But it was impossible to become a dedicated mathematician because the artist in me kept popping out at inconvenient times.



Now I am a retired math professor with fifty years of painting experience. Basically self-taught, I have completed about 400 oil and acrylic paintings, some of them atrocious failures I had to get out of my system, others sold long ago, and still others hanging in my house in Canyon Lake and stacked against the walls. I like to look at pretty scenes but I am inspired to paint those relationships of shapes and colors that yank me into contemplation. I want my viewer to enjoy a similar discovery while also appreciating how a human being chose those colors and daubed them onto a painting

I want my paintings to live on walls. Every home needs thoughtful books on shelves and real live stimulating paintings on walls.

Each year the Art League selects a two-dimensional art image to make prints to donate to organizations for charity events. We are in the process of selecting an art image for 2014 donation project. Please submit your artwork image to be juried in a competition for this project. A print of the winning entry will be given to organizations who ask for an art donation from the Art League during 2014. A print will also be given to the winning artist. The winning artist will take the responsibility to conduct the contest in the fall of 2014 and to distribute the art donation for the following year (2015).

This competition is open to all NBAL members in all styles of two-dimensional work. Each artist is allowed one entry. All artwork should be submitted in digital file by E-mail. Images should be submitted in .jpg format, RGB color, no larger than 300dpi, and 800x1200 pixels in either dimension. **Deadline for entries is November 8, 2013.** Your submission should include your name, E-mail address, and phone # with a digital file of artwork including title, dimensions, year completed and medium. E-mail your submission to Janet Chang at ichang3@satx.rr.com before November 8, 2013. The winning artist will be announced in our General Meeting in January 2014.

The team board has approved the following revision to the yearbook.

This implies that artists may begin using the new approaches to displaying photographs: Section R

- **#1.** The image must have been made with a camera. Any prints made from the original photograph are considered original art, not reproductions. (This is unchanged from 2013 yearbook)
- #2. Photographs on any substrate may be hung without mat or frame but must comply with the hanging wire requirement in section K.
- #3. Photographs displayed in bins must be protected with a clear wrap. Photographs printed on paper require a backing board and may be matted at the artist's discretion.
- #4. Photographs that are hung, if on paper, must be framed behind glass or plexiglass and may be matted. Photographs on canvas, aluminum, wood or other non paper substrate need not be framed.


