From the President...

It has been two years since I began my journey as President of this organization.

During that time the Gallery has seen an increase in visitors, in sales and overall visibility. Several new partnerships have been developed resulting in special events such as the Chamber Mixer and Artwalk Kickoff at Krause's .

We hosted a national juried show through our partnership with the Texas Watercolor Society, hosted the visiting artist reception for the "Fall into the Arts" festival for the Greater New Braunfels Arts Council and continued to showcase our beautiful gallery as an events venue. We experimented with new initiatives such as "First Friday" to increase our access to the community. We continued to host art camps for children and serve seniors at Eden Hill. Administrative challenges have been addressed and we are in good standing with our non-profit regulators.

Several much needed and costly improvements were made to our facility. We painted the building, refurbished the windows, upgraded our lighting and elevator space and replaced our roof. We have new lighting upstairs which will allow for more gallery space. Our application for HOT Funds resulted in the largest award the organization has ever received from this source, \$34,648.67, a significant increase from prior awards.

Without the support of our members our success would not have been possible. My thanks to all the active volunteers who have made all of this possible. Without your contributions, whether it be serving as a docent, assisting with events, working in our finance area, etc., we would not have been able to succeed in these endeavors and those not listed.

I also wish to thank my team, the current board, for all the hours spent assisting in the running of the organization. Good Luck to the new leadership and much success in 2018.

"Artist of the Year" Contenders

The following people are eligible to participate in the "Artist of the Year for 2017" competition, with submission on January 3, 2018 and opening January 4. The reception will be Friday, Jan 5, from 5-7:30 with the award ceremony at 6:30. These NBAL members have been a **NBAL member as of January 1, 2017 (which means they have paid on or before December 31, 2016)** and have won **Best of Show/Sponsor's Choice, or placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd at any NBAL Special Show during the year.**

Requirements for competing:

- 1. Artists must enter **3 pieces of artwork** that will be judged as a body of work.
- 2. Artists must have a single page bio that includes a photo of themselves with them when they submit their work. It will be placed with their work after the judging is finished.
- 3. Artists will be allowed **150** inches of display area, a total inch count of each work. **Maximum size is no piece** larger than a total of **84** inches.

<u>Best of Show</u>: The artist used beautiful colors in this painting and captured a swirling textured effect of movement of water. It is very pleasing to the eye.
